


Write a new football chant for the team:

Draw the biggest cake the world has ever seen!


Worlds biggest cake:

In classical ballet, there are 5 basic positions of both the feet and arms. Draw the 6 position:














COLLECTIVE

A herd of cows



ACROWD WORRY DOLLS



What ARE Worry dolls?

Worry dolls originate from Guatemala and they are handmade dolls (often tiny) that you tell all your wornies to before you go to bed - you keep them under your pillow and they help take your worries away as you steep.


Instructions:

· You can use 3 different methods to make your worry dolls.

1) twigs from the garden look for Y shaped twigs
fasten two together with
elastic bands or wool

2 lolly pop Sticks or cocktail sticks - bind together with elastic bands

(3) Using pipe cleaners and bend as Shown -




· For all 3 methods you then use different coloured wool (or thread it your worry dolls are really tiny) to dress your dolls and turn them into little characters


TOP TIPS

- · Start by tying a knot around the stick
- · Its easier to make the first knot around the body then work up to the head then back down the body

· You can use bits of scrap fabric to create simple clothes
