


Well, look at that.

Deleelelelelelelee Design and make a paper snack for the Slug Club Supermarket!


You will need:

- . Paper (including colourful paper if you have it)
- . Felt Tip Pens
- . Scissors
- . Glue Stick





Welcome to the Slug Club Supermarket! Oh no! The shelves are all empty, can you help to fill them up with paper snacks?



For a crisp sized packet you should start with an A5 piece of colourful paper.

For something chocolate sized, a smaller A6 piece of paper will be best.



Step 1:

Fold your piece of coloured paper in half so you are left with the \cHoco\perfect snack size



Cut out a round shape from white paper to be your label.



Step 3:

Design and colour in your label. Think of the name of your snack and what it would look like!

You can also make an ingredients label for the back if you like!



Step 4:

Use your glue stick to stick your label onto the front of your packet.



Step 5:

Glue along the bottom and side of the inside of your folded paper packet, and press shut.

There should be an opening at the top!



Step 6:

Remember all of the scraps you saved? Scrunch them up and put them inside your



Step 7:

Finally, add a thin line of glue along the top and packet to give a 3D effect.
